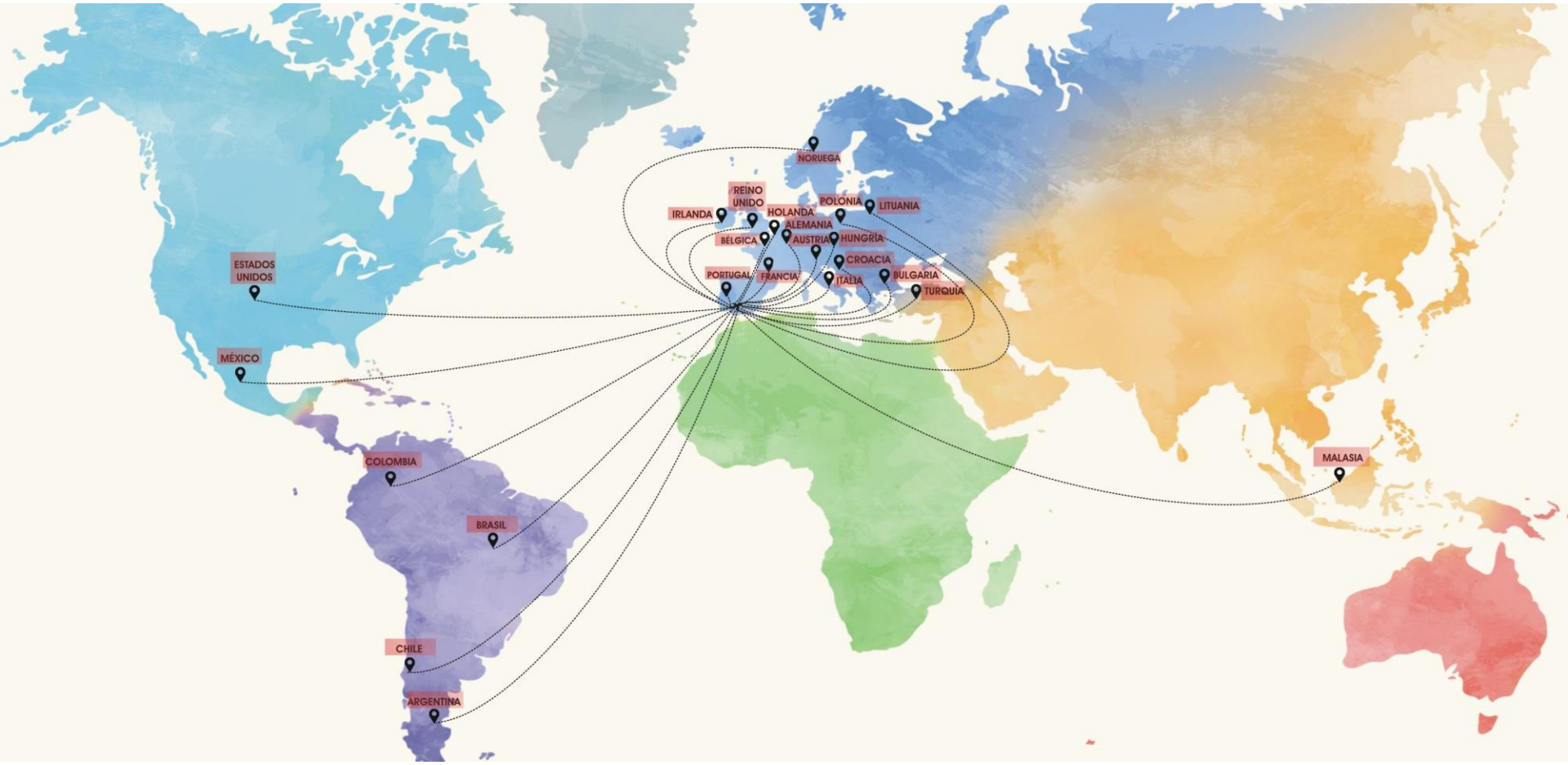

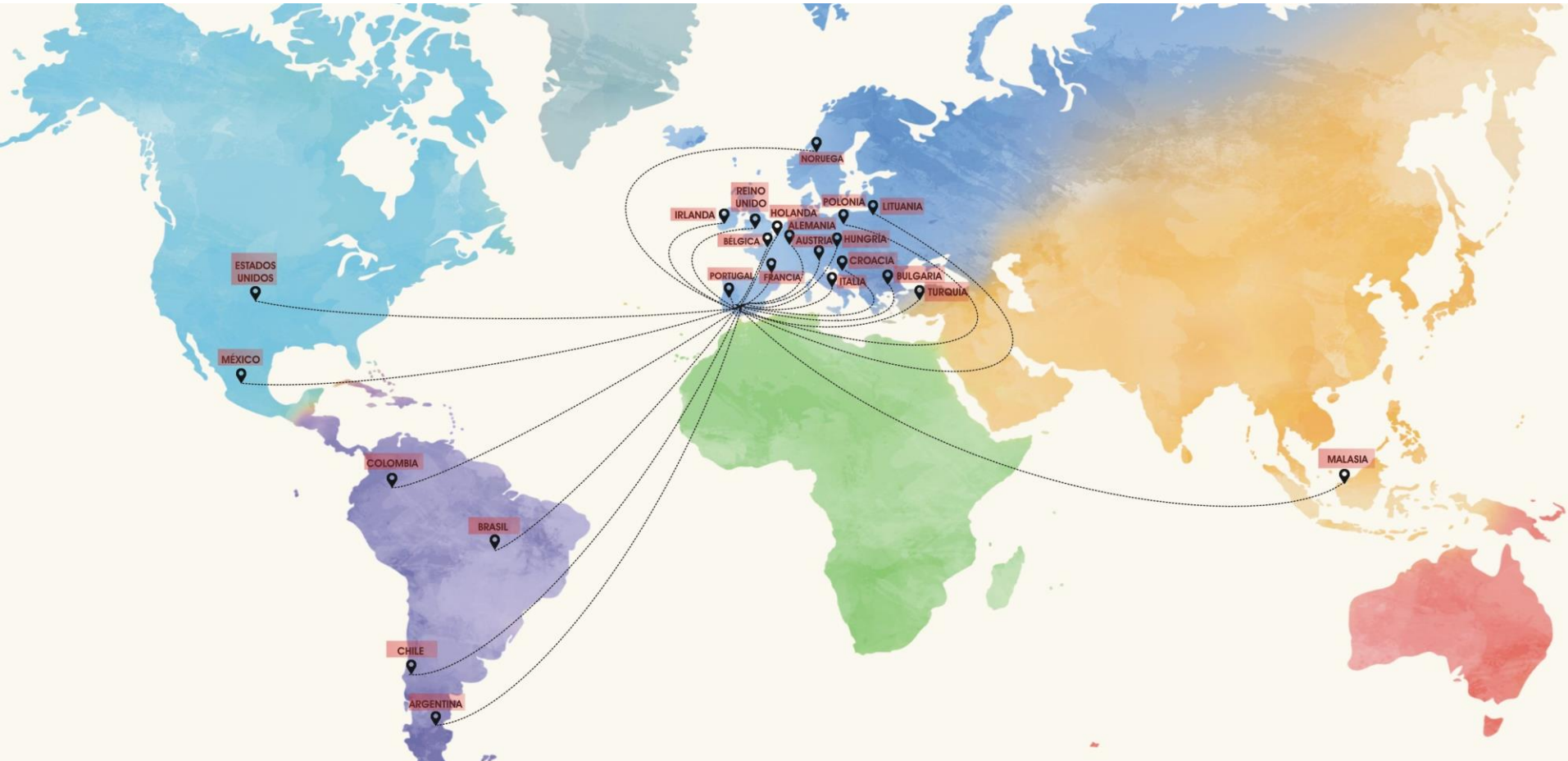

2. Starting the academic course: What do I need to do first?

1) Erasmus students: Officially announce your arrival and your departure at the IRO (Av. Ciudad Jardín 20-22, 41005 Sevilla, Spain).

-You will be provided with an **UVUS** (virtual user of the University of Seville) and a password.

With UVUS you will have access:

-Virtual Secretariat of the University of Seville (**SEVIUS**), On-line Library and **On-line learning Platform (Blackboard)**

-**"Two-factor authentication"** to access "Virtual secretary"

2) Is your **Learning agreement (LA)** signed by your Erasmus Coordinator and Seville Erasmus Coordinator?

3. Understanding our timetable.

- 1) **Classes will be in person.**
- 2) GG (large Group; theoretical group); GM (medium Group 1/2) and small group (GP 1/4).
- 3) All subjects have large group (1-6), but there are difference subjects' configurations with medium group and small groups.
- 4) When you are registered in a subject, you will be assigned to a large group (1-6). This is the number of your theoretical group. Within this large group, you will be assigned to medium group, and to a small group.
- 5) Each student can choose the large group to enroll in during the registration process (as long as there are available spots). The medium-sized group and small group can be checked in the schedules by clicking on the corresponding course and semester, and then click on 'practical groups'.
